RULES & REGULATIONS

PURPOSE: To allow young children to learn the basics of animal care, feeding and showing.

- Open to all Madison County Residents or a member of a Madison County 4-H or FFA Family. Exhibitors eligible are 5-12 years old as of June 5, 2025.
- Entry forms are available at the Madison County Extension Office and at <u>www.madisoncountyfair.net</u>. Forms must be completed and submitted to the Madison County Extension Office by the above-mentioned entry deadlines. Show superinten-dent will mail additional show information after entries are processed.
- 3. Superintendent may divide class by age of exhibitor, if necessary. All decisions of judge and superintendents are final.
- 4. Exhibitor attire: Jeans, t-shirt and closed toe shoes are appropriate.
- 5. Judging Criteria:
 - Interview with judge: How well the kid goat has been fed. Child's knowledge of kid goat and it's care.
 - b. Showmanship and handling: How well the child can handle and show the goat.
- 6. Any breed of kid goat or lamb is acceptable born after February 1, 2025 and before June 5, 2025, or under 50 lbs.
- 7. Goats do not need to be bottle fed.
- 8. Health papers not needed. Scrapie tags required for sexually intact animals.
