RULES & REGULATIONS

PURPOSE: To allow young children to learn the basics of animal care, feeding and showing.

1. Open to all Madison County Residents or a member of a Madison County 4-H or FFA Family. **Exhibitors eligible are 5-12 years old as of June 5, 2025.**
2. Entry forms are available at the Madison County Extension Office and at www.madisoncountyfair.net. Forms must be completed and submitted to the Madison County Extension Office by the above-mentioned entry deadlines. Show superintendent will mail additional show information after entries are processed.
3. Superintendent may divide class by age of exhibitor, if necessary. All decisions of judge and superintendents are final.
4. Exhibitor attire: Jeans, t-shirt and closed toe shoes are appropriate.
5. Judging Criteria:
 - a. Interview with judge: How well the kid goat has been fed. Child's knowledge of kid goat and it's care.
 - b. Showmanship and handling: How well the child can handle and show the goat.
6. Any breed of kid goat or lamb is acceptable born after February 1, 2025 and before June 5, 2025, or under 50 lbs.
7. Goats do not need to be bottle fed.
8. Health papers not needed. Scrapie tags required for sexually intact animals.
